This is Ted's plant of Ctsm. pileatum
'Imperial Court' shown last month. These are the male flowers of the plant. The female flowers are relatively insignificant in appearance.

There are not many orchids which have this type of flowerings. Although Ted has taken a liking to them, they are not the easiest to grow or transport. They are dormant in winter and lose their leaves and their growth in summer needs to be fertilised regularly and heavily. They can be difficult to grow when young; they spit their pollen out when moved abruptly.

ORCHIDWIZ: The program donated by OrchidWiz failed to attract a bidder at the auction so it was decided to use it as a raffle prize at the STOCQ AGM on 18 February. This might attract several hundred dollars. Although I said previously that the society should keep it for itself, this is against the principle of the gifting.
